

## 5. Save Ink with InkSaver (Strydent Software)

Ink cartridge prices aren't exactly a hot topic, but with costs averaging three cents per page for black and 12 cents for color, InkSaver makes a strong case for cutting expenses. New from Strydent Software, the [InkSaver program](#) allows you to configure your printer, reducing ink consumption by 25-percent increments. Supported printer models include:

- Most Hewlett-Packard Deskjet 600, 800, and 900 series.
- Most Epson Stylus C- and Color-series.
- Most Canon S- and BJC-series.

There are a few things to bear in mind though, such as InkSaver's incompatibility with Mac and laser jet printers. For further information on ink costs, see PC World's article at [this link](#). Other than that, InkSaver is now available for download with a price tag of \$35, and there are no annual licensing fees.
